Human Resources are preparing procedures and forms. Health and Safety videos are available for everyone to view at the Castlegar Campus Library: Peter will send this information to the Grapevine with a suggestion to view the ergonomics video. The greenhouse is slated for an extensive renovation after the end of the semester; wiring will be replaced at that time. The advantages of having Automated External Defibrillators on campus were discussed again with an emphasis on funding to purchase units. Mike Dion had several suggestions that he is going to pursue. Smoking restrictions are going into affect March 31st to comply with Bill C-10 2007. Signs are being placed at all building entry/exits stating no smoking within 10 meters. A complete smoking ban was discussed favorably by all present. Peter brought up the possibility of legal contest to a complete ban as duty to accommodate addictions has been argued with court precedence being set. Four free standing ashtrays have been ordered and will be placed in the areas most frequented by smokers. The key for the handicap lift in lower Sentinel is at the reception
