1. POLICY

To ensure a safe, clean and healthy learning and working environment for students, employees, and others within the institution, there shall be a "NO SMOKING" policy in all College facilities and at any public function that the College hosts and in College owned or leased vehicles. Appropriate notification of this policy shall be maintained. There shall be no smoking within ten (10) metres of any public entry door leading into the College. Smoking will be prohibited in covered walkways and entry ways. There shall be designated outdoor smoking areas with ashtrays provided. Tobacco products will not be sold on Selkirk College premises.
