1 POLICY

College equipment is purchased to support the education programs and the operation of the College. Requests received from non-profit community groups to borrow the equipment may be accommodated subject to the College's needs and policy.

2 **REGULATIONS**

- 1. Borrowing of College equipment is subject to the approval of the Direct Supervisor on the validity of the use of the equipment consistent with these regulations.
- 2. College activities have priority for the use of College equipment.
- 3. Non-profit community organizations, school boards, and other groups may borrow College equipment.
- 4. Faculty, students, and members of the community may borrow College equipment when its use is for research or study associated with an education program.
- 5. Borrowing of College equipment for private, personal use is not permitted.
- 6. The borrower will sign out and assume responsibility for the replacement or repair cost of equipment in the case of any loss or damage.
- 7. The Direct Supervisor shall ensure the borrower's ability to use the equipment in a proper manner.
