

Policy 2400: Board of Governor's Entrance Scholarships

A. PURPOSE

The Selkirk College Board of Governors offers Entrance Scholarships to students. A total of \$60,000 will be made available annually by the Board of Governor's to support recruitment from priority markets.

B. SCOPE / LIMITS

This policy applies to all students applying for the first time to a full-time academic, career/technical or trades program at Selkirk College

C. PRINCIPLES

Management of the Selkirk College Board of Governor's Entrance scholarships is delegated to the Board of Governor's Entrance Scholarship Committee. The Committee will report to the Vice President Student Advancement/Registrar and will consist of the following members:

1. Financial Aid Officer (standing position)
2. Marketing/Recruitment member (two year term)
3. Student Accessibility Services member (two year term)

Duties and Responsibilities of the Committee will be outlined in their Terms of Reference.
