GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Apply to attend Selkirk College as a full-time post-secondary student for the fall 2009 semester.
2. Students currently attending High School should complete and submit this application to the school's counselling office. Please check with your counsellor regarding his/her application deadline.

The **counselling office** is asked to **verify** the students' grades by **initialling** beside each grade and/or GPA reported, acknowledging whether this is an interim or final grade, and submitting this application directly to Selkirk College.

Applications received by Selkirk College that arrive directly from a student and not the high school will not be accepted **unless** the student is not currently attending the high school (i.e., graduated prior to this year). In that case, students must submit an official, sealed transcript from their high school with this application.

3. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
4. Selection will be based on all Grade 12 grades. Grade 11 grades will be considered where appropriate.

All applications must be received in the Financial Aid Office of Selkirk College by Thursday, April 9, 2009.

5. Selkirk College reserves the right to withhold any award for which no funds have been received or no applicant is deemed suitable.
