WORK TERM/PRACTICUM

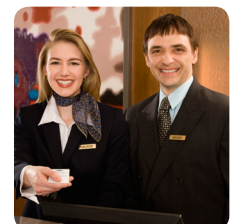
Work terms and practicums provide:

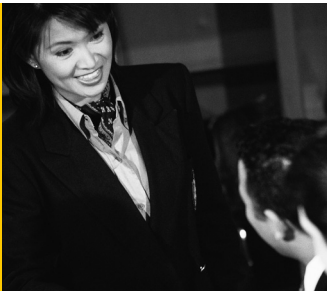
- full-time paid work experience from May through September (following 1st year classes)

POST GRADUATION OPTIONS

OPTION 1

May – Aug: Work using off campus work permit.
September: Transfer to a degree program. Resort and Hotel Management graduates from Selkirk College receive two years credit towards a four-year bachelors degrees from the following universities:

Upon graduation with a degree, it's possible to apply for a post-graduate work permit.

OPTION 2

- TOEFL score of 213 (computer) or 550 (written) or higher
- IELTS score of 6.0 or higher
- completed Level 5 (Upper Advanced) & English 051 in the Selkirk College English Language Program
- a current résumé
