

# HOMESTAY

Living with a family will help you make new friends, learn about Canadian culture, and improve your English. We recommend homestay for most new students.

## **Our Families**

Our International Student Coordinator carefully selects families who enjoy meeting students from other parts of the world. Your homestay family will provide you with three meals a day, a private room, and a warm welcome.

You will have the chance to practice and improve your English skills with family members. Your homestay family will help you to become comfortable in your new community.

### **Our Students**

We try to match our students and our homestay families as closely as we can. It is important for you to give us as much information as you can about yourself and about the kind of homestay experience you hope to have in Canada.

While we cannot guarantee to provide a perfect placement, we will do our best to place you in a home where you will be happy.

Our International Student Coordinator checks all homestay placements regularly. We provide assistance and support if needed.

# To Apply for Homestay

Complete the *Application for Homestay* form and return it with your *Application for Admission* form. Please include a short letter of introduction for your homestay family and three pictures.

We must receive your homestay application form, along with the \$100 homestay application fee, at least two months before the Semester begins.

You will receive detailed information about your homestay family approximately one month before the semester begins.

Your homestay family will meet you at the Castlegar airport when you arrive.

### Homestay Fees

#### **Initial Payments**

- \$100 homestay placement fee
- first month's homestay payment \$550

#### **Following Payment**

• subsequent homestay fees of \$550 per month are payable directly to your homestay family by you.

# SELKIRK COLLEGE INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION DEPARTMENT Application For Homestay

Although Selkirk College cannot guarantee a perfect placement, we will do our best to place you in a home where you will be happy. Students who apply for homestay are expected to stay with their host family for one full semester, (in the Fall and Winter a semester is 3-1/2 months, and in the Spring it is three months.) Students who wish to stay longer may do so. If there are any problems, the International Student Coordinator will meet with the student and the family to discuss the problem and try to find a solution.

- 1. By making this application, I understand that I am expected to stay with the host family for <u>one full semester</u> (three and one half months in the Fall or Winter and three months in the Spring.)
- 2. I understand that the first month's homestay payment of \$550 must be paid to Selkirk College no later than one month before my arrival. I agree to pay \$550 to my family each month on the monthly anniversary of the date that I arrive.
- 3. I agree to get medical insurance when I arrive.
- 4. I understand that my personal belongings will **not** be covered by my host family's insurance and that I should obtain my own personal insurance.
- 5. I understand that if I decide to leave after the first semester I must give my host family written notice 30 days before leaving.
- 6. I agree to pay for any damages or outstanding expenses, such as telephone bills, before I leave my host family.
- 7. I give permission to Selkirk College to give the first page of this application to the host family as part of my personal profile.
