Selkirk International staff are dedicated to providing complete support for your success. From the moment you arrive, you will receive personal help and attention with your academic courses and personal matters.


facilities

English Language Program (ESL)

Selkirk International provides options for students who want to develop their English communication skills. Please note that you do not require a TOEFL score to apply for the English Language Program, and study permits are not required for short-term programs of six months or less.

English language program

Students in the English Language
Program learn to read, speak and write
English with skill and confidence. There
are 6 levels, from Fundamental to College
Preparation. The classes are full-time (22
hours per week), and taught by highly
qualified and experienced instructors.
Certificates are given upon successful
completion of each level.

The Selkirk College English Language Program is accredited with Languages Canada, the primary professional organization for institutional language programs in Canada.

English language and beyond

In addition to the six levels included in English Language Program, students may complete these advanced level options:

TESOL ADVANCED DIPLOMA Learn how to teach others to communicate in English with this advanced post-graduate diploma; 1 semester (4 months).


The Selkirk College TESOL Advanced Diploma Program is accredited with TESL Canada, the main professional organization in Canada for teachers of English.

Selkirk College offers a wide variety of career programs. In order to be eligible for admission to college programs, international students must:

- Complete English as a Second Language Level 5 and English 51, or
- Have completed BC English 12 or equivalent; or a TOEFL score of 213; or IELTS score of 6.5

work experience opportunities at Selkirk College

Employment within the community is a great way to improve English skills. To be eligible for off-campus employment, students must have finished 6 months of study in a recognized diploma program or a course of studies leading to a degree. English Language (ESL) students do not qualify.

accommodation

HOMESTAY - the best choice for new students
Staying with a Canadian family offers the best opportunity
to speak English and learn about Canadian family life
and culture. All homestay accommodations include a
private room, 3 meals per day, and laundry facilities. A
minimum of 4 months (1 semester) is recommended.

DORMITORY/RESIDENCE - a good choice for independent students with good language skills
Kekuli House Residence, conveniently located on the Castlegar campus, is home to students from Canada and around the world. It provides private rooms with a shared bathroom, cooking facilities, and a common room with TV and pool table.

admission & study permit

- Selkirk College will send a letter of acceptance, invoice and bank information once the application and transcripts have been reviewed.
- All international students must complete a student medical information form to submit with their tuition payment before the start of classes.
- Tuition fees can be paid by credit card, bank draft, bank transfer or international money order.
- Take the official letter of acceptance to the Canadian Embassy or High Commission for the study permit.

health care

 The British Columbia government requires all international students to have medical insurance while studying in Canada. Students may have insurance from their home country or apply for insurance upon arrival in Canada.

how to apply to Selkirk College:

- No TOEFL score is required for the English Language Program. Students may enter other college programs upon successful completion of Level 5 and English 51.
- For direct entry into Academic University Transfer, Certificate or Diploma programs, students must have English 12 or equivalent; or
- a TOEFL score of 79-80 (iBT) or 213 (CBT); or IELTS score of 6.5. Apply by mail, fax or Internet.
- Send official copies of transcripts or records of grades to the International Admissions Office. Send the complete application with \$100 CDN non-refundable processing fee.
