## How to Prepare for MATH 100

Welcome to the **School of University Arts and Sciences** at Selkirk College. Because **Math 100 (Calculus I)** is a particularly challenging course, we want to let all our incoming Math 100 students know how best to prepare for success in this course:

1. **Please enroll in Math 097 (Preparation for Calculus), which runs from Monday, August 27 to Friday, August 31, 2012 from 1 – 4 pm.** This **free** course will refresh your pre-calculus skills and knowledge to prepare you for Math 100. 2. Work through the [Math 100 – Review Package](http://www.selkirk.ca/courses/uas/math-100/) on the School of University Arts and Sciences website at <http://www.selkirk.ca/courses/uas/math-100/>. The review materials cover the skills learned in your senior high school math courses. This review package will also help you prepare for the skills assessment test that will take place during the first week of our Math 100 classes. 3. If you find that you need to start with Math 51 (Algebra and Trigonometry II) instead, then you can switch into Math 51 in the fall semester and enroll in Math 100 in the winter semester, followed by Math 101 (Calculus II) in the spring semester so that you will still fulfill your first-year math needs and be ready to take second-year math the following fall.
4. Once you start MATH 100 this September, please know that you may also use our **free Math/Sciences/Statistics tutoring** services located up in the Library.
