Join us for a continuation of a community dialogue about the future use of the Brilliant Terrace lands.

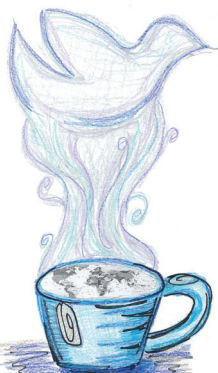
