- By-law will increase their patrols daily.
- Gas smell at Silver King student commons
 - Able to isolate to the exhaust pan not being turned on it is the only place that operates on gas.
 - H&S worked closely with the fire department on procedures.
 - Continues to cause concerns for some employees last Friday a technician completed their inspection. The gas was turned on, and a small smell of gas went throughout the building. Historically the facility team is called directly – it is requested to follow the procedure on the myselkirk website and call the facilities coordinator. There were no facility team members on site – the employees were directed to call the non-emergency number. The fire alarm was pulled. The fire alarm department arrived. The fire department was not pleased with the call, and believed it was not an emergency, and the College could be fined for similar situations in the future.
 - Facilities are working on a procedure. Following the guidance of Fortis.
