Summary of Indigenous population and Indigenous learners:

4.9% of Canada's total population is Indigenous; of those, 16% reside in British Columbia, making 5.9% of BC's total population Indigenous. 1.98% of BC's Indigenous population, live in the Selkirk College region (Central Kootenay & Kootenay Boundary census divisions)

The BC Indigenous population represents 6.5% of domestic FTEs in the public post-secondary system; of those, 22.8% attend institutions in the Thompson Okanagan/Kootenay Region

Indigenous learners at Selkirk College only represent 1.9% of all Indigenous FTEs in the BC public post-secondary system, but 10.1% of FTEs at Selkirk College are attributed to Indigenous learners (CDW, May 2016)
