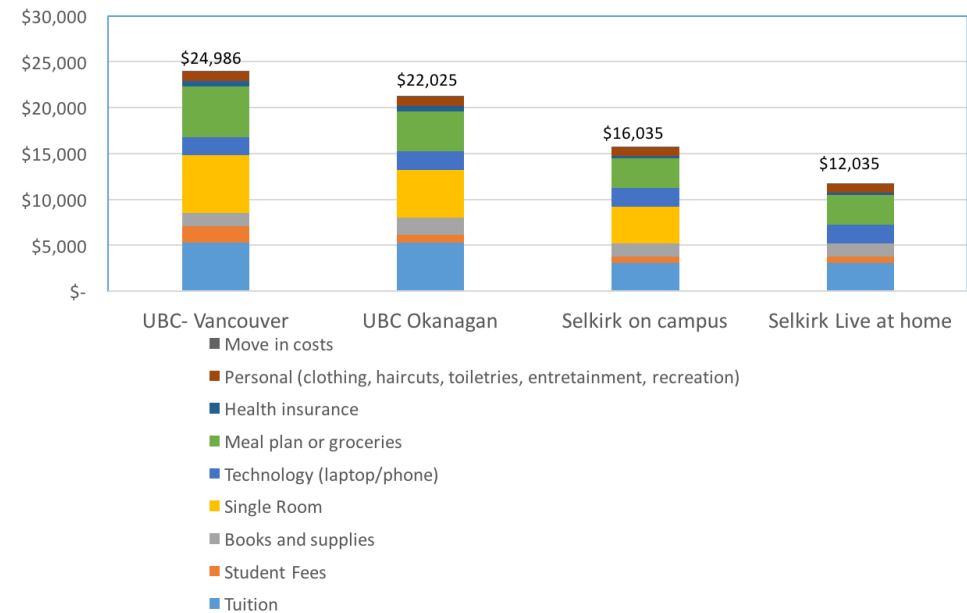
POST-GRADUATE ACCOUNTING (PGDA)
