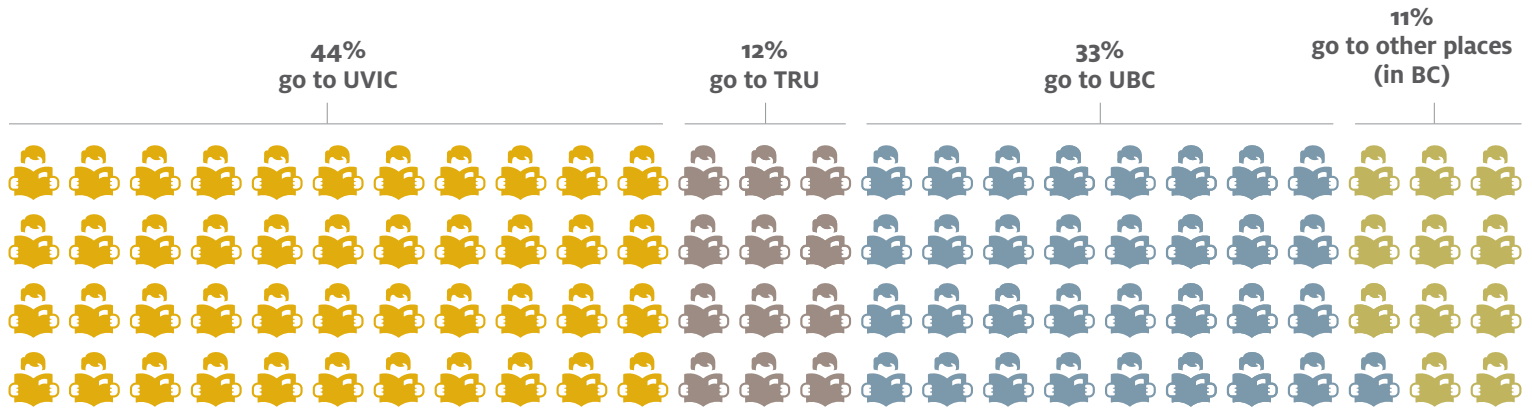

*The average GPA of Selkirk College students in the first semester rates well against other colleges. For example, going to UBCO Selkirk students performed better than those of any other college in the first semester.*

*The average GPA of Selkirk College students when they complete their degree also rates well against other colleges: Selkirk students going to UVIC average **3.62** (on a 4 point scale) upon degree completion. Selkirk students going to UBC average around **78%**.*
