







University Arts & Sciences Transfers by Numbers


Approximately **100 students per year** transfer from Selkirk College to other post secondary institutions to continue their education. Of those students ...

The average GPA of Selkirk College students in the first semester rates well against other colleges. For example, going to UBCO Selkirk students performed better than those of any other college in the first semester.



The average GPA of Selkirk College students when they complete their degree also rates well against other colleges: Selkirk students going to UVIC average 3.62 (on a 4 point scale) upon degree completion. Selkirk students going to UBC average around 78%.

MONTHS FOR THE AVERAGE SELKIRK COLLEGE STUDENT TO COMPLETE THEIR DEGREE.

The average student gets about 52 credits of transfer (this average includes students who only go to Selkirk for one year).
