

Start toward your Foundation/Apprenticeship Level 1 Technical Training in a variety of trade areas. High school students receive a combination of practical, hands-on and theory-based training leading to graduation and recognized industry certification.

APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS

Apprenticeship combines paid, work-based training with in-school technical training. Interprovincial Red Seal trade certification is awarded upon successful completion of both components.

In-class technical training is offered in the following trades:

- Carpentry Levels 1-4 7 weeks each
- Hairstylist Level 2 5 weeks
- Electrical Levels 1-4 10 weeks each
- Welding: Modular Level B 16 weeks and Level A – 8 weeks, Apprenticeship Level 1 & 2 – 8 weeks, Level 3 – 10 weeks, Multi Process Alloy Welding – 5 weeks, Upgrader Welding (self-paced)

PRE-EMPLOYMENT CAREER PROGRAMS

Plant Operator – 24 weeks Through a combination of 18 weeks of class/shop with six weeks of work experience, you will develop entry-level skills that are required to monitor and control equipment and process units in large industrial plants.
