### INDUSTRY & TRADES TRAINING

Desk jobs aren't for everyone. Do you value hands-on work in a career with great earning potential? Do you want to see direct results from your efforts and have your skills provide incredible value? Thousands of job openings are expected in the skilled trades in coming years with employment opportunities offering diverse work in a variety of industries.

#### FOUNDATION PROGRAMS

Learn through practical shop experience and theoretical classroom training to develop the skills and knowledge necessary to start as a working apprentice in:

- Carpentry – 24 weeks
- Electrical – 24 weeks
- Fine Woodworking – 36 weeks

- Hairstylist – 36 weeks
- Heavy Mechanical – 36 weeks
- Metal Fabricator – 23 weeks
- Millwright/Machinist – 36/30 weeks
- Welding – 28 weeks

#### YOUTH TRAIN IN TRADES

##### AVAILABLE TO STUDENTS:

- Grade 12
- ages 16 to 18-years-old
- who have not achieved high school graduation

Participating students are registered as an apprentice with the Industry Training Authority and their school district is their sponsor.

Start toward your Foundation/Apprenticeship Level 1 Technical Training in a variety of trade areas. High school students receive a combination of practical, hands-on and theory-based training leading to graduation and recognized industry certification.

#### APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMS

Apprenticeship combines paid, work-based training with in-school technical training. Interprovincial Red Seal trade certification is awarded upon successful completion of both components.

In-class technical training is offered in the following trades:

- Carpentry Levels 1-4 – 7 weeks each
- Hairstylist Level 2 – 5 weeks
- Electrical Levels 1-4 – 10 weeks each
- Welding: Modular Level B – 16 weeks and Level A – 8 weeks, Apprenticeship Level 1 & 2 – 8 weeks, Level 3 – 10 weeks, Multi Process Alloy Welding – 5 weeks, Upgrader Welding (self-paced)

#### PRE-EMPLOYMENT CAREER PROGRAMS

Plant Operator – 24 weeks

Through a combination of 18 weeks of class/shop with six weeks of work experience, you will develop entry-level skills that are required to monitor and control equipment and process units in large industrial plants. There is excellent local employment and salary potential for graduating students.
