Getting to Nelson B.C. and Selkirk College

Fly to Castlegar (YCG) with Air Canada/Jazz

Fly from Vancouver or Calgary to Castlegar approximately 42km from Nelson. Visit aircanada.com to view flight schedules and prices.

Airport Shuttle departs from Castlegar Airport to Nelson at selected times throughout the day. Visit kootenayshuttle.com/castlegar for schedule and fares. Shuttle drops off/picks up at both the Prestige Lakeside Resort and the Hume Hotel. Reservations are recommended day before travel. Limited bus service with Transit BC is available on Route 99 between Castlegar and Nelson view bctransit.com for details.

Budget and Enterprise car rental is available from Castlegar, view prices and availability at budget.ca and enterpriserentacar.ca use airport code YCG for pickup location.

Fly to Trail (YZZ) with Pacific Coastal

Fly from Vancouver, Victoria, Cranbrook, Campbell River and other B.C. locations to Trail, approximately 70km from Nelson. Visit pacificcoastal.com for schedules and booking.

From the West/South on entering Nelson merge with highway 3A, follow highway 3A through Nelson towards the orange bridge. On Nelson Ave turn right onto Elwyn St and turn left once you get to 10th St.

From the North follow highway 3A across the lake and turn left onto Elwyn St and left once you get to 10th St.
